FCC Registration New users must get an FCC Registration Number (FRN)

If you wish to conduct business with the FCC, you must first register through the FCC's Commission Registration System (CORES). Upon registration, you will be assigned a FCC Registration Number (FRN). This number will be used to uniquely identify you in all transactions with the FCC.

About the FCC Registration Number (FRN)

An FRN is a 10-digit number that is assigned to a business or individual registering with the FCC. This unique FRN is used to identify the registrant's business and to track the registrant's filings with the FCC. The FCC will use the FRN to determine if all of a registrant's fees have been paid. You are encouraged to register with the Commission as soon as possible to do business with the FCC. If you have not yet registered, you will be ready to access any of our electronic licensing systems without having to go through the registration process at the time you submit an application.

The FCC's Wireless Telecommunications Bureau requires the FRN for the Universal Licensing System and Antenna Structure Registration on December 3, 2001.

FCC Registration Number Summary (FRN)

- Check to see if your agency already has a valid FRN. If you're not sure, search on the FCC web site
- If no FRN, log in and create one
- In the FCC menus, use “[business](#)”, even if you are a non-profit or government agency, if there are no other appropriate selections.


